

Spring 2018 Faculty-Student Research Convention



The College Research Committee is pleased to announce that the spring 2018 Faculty-Student Research Convention on the theme **Creative Teaching** is scheduled on 18th May 2018.

Creative teaching is an interaction of many intellectual concepts such as: imagination, analytical inquiries, sound reasoning, participation and reflection, field study, object study, modeling etc., by which students prepare themselves for an emerging world.

Presentations based on proposal, empirical research, action research, case studies, design studies, policy brief, literature review, reflective paper and scholarly communication are invited from faculty members, student researchers, and teachers from nearby schools to be shared during the convention.

Guidelines for Abstracts Submission:

1. All abstracts must be submitted and presented in English using British English spelling.
2. Please use the abstract template and structure your abstract with the headings:
 - Background
 - Materials/methods
 - Results
 - Conclusions
 - Key words
3. Abstracts should be based on the theme 'Creative Teaching' in any subject disciplines.
4. Abbreviations should be defined the first time they appear in your text. Example: HEA (Higher Education Area), before being used as an abbreviation only. Please, do not define or use abbreviations in the title.
5. Abstract titles must be submitted according to the general rules. This includes any special characters and special words that need to be capitalized or in italics. Abstract titles will be proofread. Titles in ALL CAPS (other than abbreviations or acronyms) are not allowed.



6. Authors are asked to enter a minimum of three keywords to better define the abstract content.
7. The text must be formatted in Arial font size 12.
8. The abstract text may not be longer than 350 words.
9. Tables, charts or other graphics may not be included and will be deleted by the editors.
10. All abstracts should have summarized curriculum vitae of author/authors
11. The notification of acceptance/rejection of the abstracts submitted will be sent to you via email by **4th May, 2018**.
